What Could Possibly Go Wrong?

- Is your developer qualified?
- · What's the builders track record?
- Clear understanding of the project
- · Bond?
- Condo association or other ownership entities?
- · Stick built.....
- How does the plan fit into your current culture or future plans?
- Should there be a development agreement?
- Communicate Communicate



Contractor Procurement and Construction Options – Airport Elements

- Procurement Method Low bid, quotes, or alternate method
- Bid Schedule(s) Horizontal and vertical combined or separate
 - Separate bid schedule for grant eligible items
- Base Bid and Alternates Maximum "bang for the buck"
- Self Performance Work Clearing, grading, drainage
- Self Performance Service Serve as General Contractor
- Construction Sequencing Minimize traffic on pavement



Construction Administration and Oversight

- Tighter Tolerances Pavement grades and drainage
- Simplify Construction WSDOT or local specifications if able
- "Inspection" Owner can perform some or all with support from engineering consultant as needed
- Cost Management Contractor "check-ins" and WSDOT force account process to control costs



Project Closeout

- Substantial Completion Walkthrough/Commissioning
 - Doors, utilities, lights, unused screw holes in roof, wall sheeting offset from concrete
- Construction Completion Final acceptance and payment
- Grant Closeout
- Walkthrough Prior to End of Warranty





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
